

General Pack Information

Pack Meetings

Pack meetings are generally held once a month, during the school year. They are usually held on a Thursday from 7-8pm, and the Lee gymnasium. Parents are required to attend the Pack Meetings with their son. Pack meetings are filled with awards, advancements, announcements, skits, and other activities. Parents should have their scout in uniform, in the gym and seated by 6:55pm.

Den Meetings

Individual dens generally meet 2-3 times a month. The time, place and day are left up to the den leader and scout parents to decide. Parents are encouraged to assist the leaders throughout the year with meetings, activities, field trips, etc. Achievement activities will be the focus of the den meetings; however parents and their scouts are responsible for completing the achievement requirements for advancement.

Uniforms

New uniforms may be purchased at the Scout Shop (4295 S. Garnett Rd.) or at Bayouth's Dept. Store (207 E. Dewey, Sapulpa). Staff in the shops can assist in getting the right patches, numbers, etc. for your uniform. Just tell them the cub's rank, den number, and that you are a member of Pack 49.

Tiger Cubs: The Tiger Cub uniform consists of a blue uniform shirt with the Tiger Cub insignia, Tiger neckerchief with slide, dark jeans or pants, cap and Cub Scout belt. It is recommended to buy the Cub Scout belt buckle and slide instead of the Tiger, since it can be used throughout the Cub years. It is not necessary to purchase the Tiger recognition kit as this will be provided by the den leader.

Cub Scouts (2nd-5th): The basic Cub Scout uniform requirements are as follows:

- *Shirt:* Wolf and Bears wear blue shirts. Webelos wear khaki. Shirts can be long or short sleeves. It is recommended to buy the short sleeve shirt big enough to wear over a turtleneck during the winter months.
- *Scarf w/slide:* Each rank has a different color scarf. The Pack usually gives out the scarves for the upcoming year at the Spring Campout.
- *Cub Scout belt*
- *Other:* Scout pants and socks are available but not required. Denim jeans or pants with belt loops, dark socks and shoes are acceptable. Wild pants, bright colored pants, sandals and thongs are not acceptable and disrespectful to the uniform.
